Ben Brown, conductor

Mr. Brown is an Assistant Band Director at Poteet High School in Mesquite, TX. He is in his 14th year of teaching and his 2nd at Poteet High School. At Poteet, Mr. Brown directs the Symphonic Band, which is the 2nd performing ensemble and assists with the Poteet Pirate Band. Most recently, the Pirate Band traveled to San Antonio to compete in the UIL Class 5A State Marching Band Competition. Under his direction, the Poteet Symphonic Band earned superior ratings at last year's UIL Concert/Sight-reading Contest, continuing a tradition of over 2 decades of 1st division ratings at UIL. Prior to his teaching at Poteet, Mr. Brown was Director of Bands at Kennedale Junior High. At Kennedale, Mr. Brown's bands earned sweepstakes awards at the UIL Concert and Sight Reading Contest, consistently advanced to the area and state level competition in the ATSSB Outstanding Performance Series, winning in 2016 and 2018, and advanced to the area level for the 2015 Honor Band competition, coming in 3rd. Mr. Brown has guest conducted honor groups in Texas, is an active adjudicator, and is a faculty member at the Tarleton State University and Stephen F. Austin State University Summer Band Camps. He is a member of TMEA, TMAA, TBA, and a life member of Kappa Kappa Psi. He resides in Mesquite, TX and enjoys time on the lake as well as home improvement projects.
